2023 Kids Club Open Free Time Agreement

Welcome to Kids Club Open Free Time! All children ages 1- 9 years old may attend.

1. Reservations are required for using our Kids Club Open Free Time and must be made 24 hours in advance. **No drop-ins.**
2. Kids Club Open Free Time is for BIRC members only and is free of charge.
3. Kids Club Open Free Times are Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday through Sunday from 5:00-7:00p.
4. Schedule is subject to changes and cancelations due to holidays, Park District programs, events, and functions.
5. The Kids Club door and shades must always be left open.
6. A parent/guardian must always be present in the Kids Club with their child.
7. A guardian must be at least 18 years of age. One guardian per family.
8. Kids Club Open Free Time hours are not exclusive. Multi-families may use the space at one time. The max in the room is eight total.
9. For the health protection of other children and the staff, please do not bring sick children into the Kids Club. If your child appears to be sick, they may be turned away at the staff's discretion.
10. In the interest of children with food allergies, food is not allowed. Bottles and sippy cups are permitted.
11. For health and safety reasons, we require that children wear shoes and/or socks at all times. Flip-flops and sandals are not allowed unless worn with socks.
12. Parents/Guardians are responsible for any Kids Club missing or broken items.
13. Parents/Guardians are responsible for putting away all toys, art supplies, and chairs where they were originally located. All items used, such as toys, art supplies, tables, and counters, must be wiped down and sanitized.
14. The Kids Club Open Free Time Check Out Sheet must be returned to the front desk after Kids Club room use.
15. I understand that if I do not abide by the rules as stated above or any rules within the membership agreement, or code of conduct, my approval of using the Kids Club Open Time may be terminated.

The signature below acknowledges that the parent/guardian has read, understood, and agreed to abide by the foregoing rules. The parent/guardian agrees to indemnify and hold Bainbridge Island Metro Park & Recreation District and its employees harmless from any claims for damages or injury their child(ren) may cause or inflict on any other child and releases Bainbridge Island Metro Park & Recreation District and its employees from any claims, demands or liability which may arise out of providing Kids Club.
